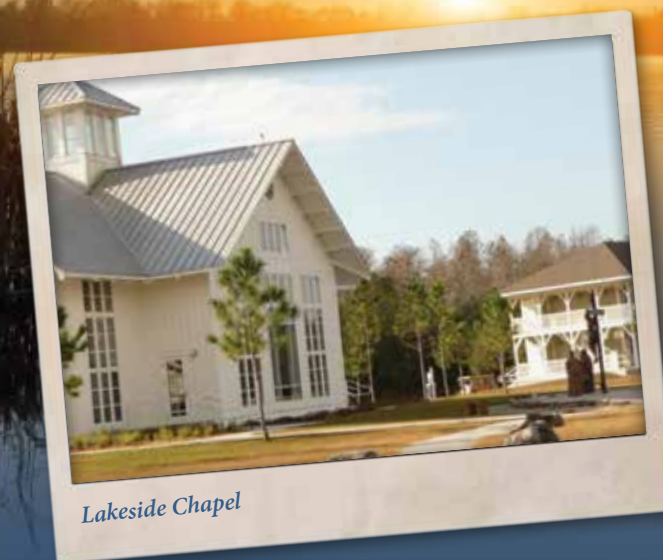

## RETREAT DIRECTOR



Retreat Director **Mother Olga Yaqob** is a tiny, energetic 45-year-old Iraqi nun, who radiates Christ's love to all. Her quiet, soft-spoken nature draws you to her. And, when you are with her, you know you are in the presence of holiness.

With great risk to her own personal safety, Mother Olga ministered to the poor and the imprisoned in her native Iraq. Through this selfless service, she became known as the "Mother Teresa of Baghdad." While in Baghdad, she established the Order of the Missionaries of the Virgin Mary, the first religious order of women to be established in the Assyrian Church of the East in over 700 years.

Mother Olga graduated with honors from the Urbani-ana University in Rome and holds a Masters Degree in Pastoral Ministry from Boston College, where she was also named University Chaplain. Mother was received into the Catholic Church in September, 2005, and was recently entrusted with the mission of establishing a new religious community of sisters in the Archdiocese of Boston called The Daughters of Mary of Nazareth.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

The cottages at the Bethany Center offer new, beautiful private rooms, each with a queen bed, private bath, desk and a comfortable reading chair. In addition, each room also has a single bed tucked away to allow double occupancy. All meals will be provided, however, each cottage also has a small group gathering room equipped with a microwave oven, small refrigerator, coffee pot and ice maker.



The Cottages feature wrap-around porches with rocking chairs – perfect to enjoy the sunset views overlooking the nearby lake. A one-mile walking trail follows the shoreline of the quiet lake; gazebos along the path invite private meditation as well as just being a lovely spot to experience the natural setting.

## THE RETREAT

The retreat will begin Monday afternoon, April 22 at 2:00 pm and close Wednesday the 24th after lunch. Room check-in begins at noon.

Attendees will have time for private meditation and prayer. You will have the opportunity to spend time with Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration. We will gather for Mass, the Rosary and Stations of the Cross.

Mother Olga will guide us in contemplating God's Word in the Bible. She will spend time with each person offering spiritual direction. A priest will be available for reconciliation.

Detailed information will be emailed two weeks prior to the retreat to all who have registered to attend.
